Augsburg has always been about care and compassion. In fact our mission statement, “... to care for our residents as if they were the Lord, Himself” is a bold statement and a lofty calling; a calling we strive to fulfill to honor our Lord, Jesus Christ. Our care givers and staff work with the love of our Savior in their service. They show the love of Jesus every day in so many ways. With that said, Augsburg provides the care and shelter, but you, our financial partners, assist us in providing the mission.

This addition of the Augsburg Bulletin lists those *Partners in Mission*; individuals, congregations and businesses that have chosen to support Augsburg financially. We are grateful for their continued support and their commitment to our Christian mission. Their financial support, and yours, provides the extra margin that allows Augsburg to be a leading organization in the compassionate care of the aging.

Your charitable dollars are used in many ways here at Augsburg Village. Most importantly, it is used to cover the cost associated with caring for our residents who have outlived their financial resources. It assures their physical and spiritual needs are met. It allows them to stay in their *home* with their *friends*.

Many of those residents who receive benevolent care reside in our Assisted Living community. Without the support from our *Partners in Mission*, many would have nowhere else to go. Donations ensure they get the nourishment, health care, and spiritual care they deserve, as a child of God.

In addition, charitable support helps to bridge the gap of Medicaid reimbursement and the actual cost of caring for residents in our Health Care Center. This is significant because 75% of our Health Care Center residents are on Medicaid. Because the Medicaid reimbursement is significantly lower than the cost of care, Augsburg is forced to absorb an annual operating loss. Your charitable support helps to cover the difference and allows us to provide compassionate care.

Some *Partners in Mission* choose to support Augsburg through our Resident Care Fund, which is a restricted fund that supports residents directly. The fund is unique because it cannot be used to provide benevolent care. It must be used to purchase tangible items that promote dignity, self-esteem and quality of life.

The Resident Care Fund provides wheelchairs, dentures, eye glasses, personal items and other essentials that residents can no longer afford to purchase for themselves. Charitable support to this fund provides a direct connection, an opportunity to improve and enhance the daily lives of our residents.

Additionally, Augsburg is blessed to receive donations that are directed to numerous other ministries within our walls. Some generous donors support our Pastoral Care Ministry. We are fortunate to have a full-time pastor, who provides communion, leads bible studies, visits residents and meets the spiritual needs of both residents and staff. This additional support directed toward our Christian mission facilitates our residents’ continued walk with God.

Other *Partners in Mission* have chosen to support our Therapeutic Recreation Department or to purchase benches, chairs and items of need. It amazes me how often a family member or volunteer will see a need and graciously decide to donate to advance the Augsburg mission.

Also, Augsburg is fortunate to have an active and faithful Auxiliary. With the sole purpose of supporting Augsburg, the Auxiliary raises money through the operation of the Augsburg Gift Shop. Their financial support is used to improve the lives of our residents. This past year, they started a monthly concert series that has brought a broad spectrum of talent for our residents to enjoy.

As the passage from Galatians instructs, *let us work for the good of all, and especially for those of the family of faith*.

On behalf of the Administration, Staff, Board of Directors, and most importantly, the residents of Augsburg, thank you for another year of generous support!
