Operation Gratitude will provide the following payments to eligible team members:

For full time team members, a total of \$1,500 paid in three equal payments For part time team members, a total of \$750 paid in three equal payments For PRN team members, a total of \$300 paid in three equal payments

To support your efforts over the coming months, Operation Gratitude payments will be paid in the months of: April 2020, August 2020 and November 2020

Eligibility:

- You must be an hourly team member providing direct care or services
 physically in a community or a client's home during the COVID-19 pandemic
 crisis
- Your employment must remain in good standing throughout the length of Operation Gratitude
- You must be employed at the time Operation Gratitude payments are distributed
